"Okay," Janet responded, her voice carrying a tone of reassurance.

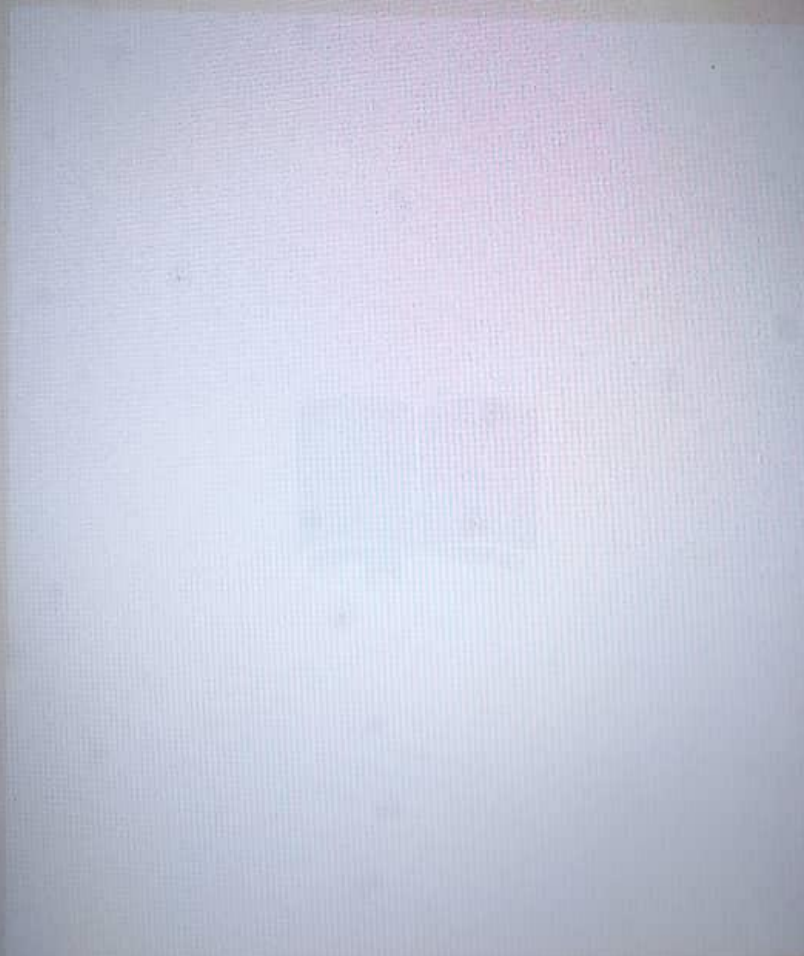
Johanna then turned to Nightingale. "Nightingale, would you mind taking Janet back home? I have other matters to attend to. Thank you."
